

Notification of Updated QP Riders, 2232391 Rev AB and
First Article Inspection Training

Dear Valued Supplier,

This letter is to provide notification of the QP Rider document revision that will become effective for all Purchase Orders within January 2026, including existing and new Purchase Orders. The changes to existing QP Rider requirements are clarification in nature and do not add to the work scope or delivery scope. The detailed description of the changes are in the final pages of the 2232391 Rev AB document, available on the Teledyne Controls website at <https://www.teledynecontrols.com/en-us/suppliers/Pages/Quality.aspx>.

Highlight Changes:

New QP Rider 100: General QP Rider

QP Rider 100 is a General QP Rider that includes Quality Management System process types of requirements. QP Rider 100 incorporates and obsoletes the following list of QP Riders: 103, 122, 126, 160, 196, 217, 220, 233, 235, 238, 268

For all Purchase Orders listing one of the above QP Riders, the new applicable requirement is QP Rider 100.

The only required deliverable item of QP Rider 100 is a Certificate of Conformance (previously QP Rider 160). All other reports and notifications within QP Rider 100 are only deliverable when applicable.

Product Safety Reporting: Product Safety Reporting is a new requirement with QP Rider 100 to report product safety issues, hazards, concerns, occurrences, incidents, as well as proposed solutions and safety improvements that are identified or occur to their Teledyne Controls purchasing representative.

Updated QP Rider 271: First Article Inspection Report

QP Rider 105 is combined into QP Rider 271. The QP Rider 271 is clarified with verbiage from AS9102C and it's now required for suppliers to manage when a FAIR is required to be delivered to Teledyne Controls following the criteria from AS9102. Purchase Orders with QP Rider 271 applicable items may begin to always flow down QP Rider 271, no longer when Teledyne Controls is aware that a new AS9102 FAIR is required to be delivered.
